


promotional virtual exhibition to 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Czech Olympic Committee, called **OLYMPSPORT 2009**, was organized. These exhibitions are still available on the Japhila server (<http://www.japhila.cz>) as an example and inspiration for new and beginner exhibitors. Out of the international exhibitions our participation in the Olympilex exhibitions dominates, continuously from Olympilex 1985 in Lausanne till the Olympilex 2008 in Peking. The members have a well-equipped library at their disposal, and they may turn to the experienced exhibitors and jurymen with their requests regarding the reinforcing and tuition of their exhibits.



A novelties service has been established for the members and the interested public. It enables to gain regularly new postal material regarding the



sport and Olympic matters. We have also been successfully co-operating with the Czech Post in the creation of new postmarks. We also provide postal promotional services in the cancellations and stationaries production not only for the Czech Olympic Committee, but also for the individual sport federations and clubs, and the public.

To the 45-years-anniversary, a range of the philatelist material was prepared. A process-block for the Postalia appliances serves as the basis. It commemorates the double gold of Martin Doktor in the Olympic Games in Atlanta in 1996. The block has been used twice: as a franking machine to cancel the celebration invitations, and as obliteration stamps in black that were printed on the stationary signed by Martin Doktor at his autography presentation. The most required were the envelopes with the additional printing of the view of the Chocerady church, stamped with the private stamps with the Olympsport sign, and hand-stamped with the occasional stamp with the portrait of Jarda Justýn, one of the „ fathers founders“, Jarda Justýn.

## Best practices from Czech Federation

### 1. ČESKO – SLOVENSKÁ FILATELISTICKÁ VÝSTAVA



VYSOKÉ MÝTO 12. – 16.10. 2011

We are preparing the **“First Czech – Slovak Philatelic Exhibition”** in the city Vysoke Myto with a significant new approach which will be held in October 12. - 16. 2011. It will be **“Two in One”** exhibition (National and Premiere-category) for all competitive classes, supporting cross-border cooperation with Slovak Republic.

An „innovate“ way of the evaluation of the exhibits has been proposed using the virtual philatelic exposition platform called **EXPONET**. Every exhibitor would deliver a scanned material copy by 31.7.2011. (see the instructions on the [www.exponet.info](http://www.exponet.info)) These would be placed into a separate section of the website.

The jury members would evaluate the exhibits in advance. At the exhibition they would then verify that the exhibit really exists, and they would also check eventual disputable issues. Thus the jury would come with already prepared evaluation to the exhibition, and would finalize/confirm it having it discussed in the team. If wished so, the exhibit would not be exhibited in real, yet it would be evaluated. The exhibitor would only present the exhibit to the jury according to the date and time scheduled by the jury in advance. Only those exhibit whose exhibitors would be interested and would mark that in the application form, would be actually exhibited at the exhibition. A selection would be made taking into account the limited exhibition capacity, and with respect to the representation of all exhibition classes.

The organizational committee is the only and final body to decide about the selection of the presented exhibits.
