

Salon Planete Timbres, 8 – 17 June 2012 in Paris

Phil@poste – La Poste France has announced that they as part of their continued support to Philately in June 2012 will organize a “Salon Planete Timbre 2012”.

Like in 2010 Phil@poste wants in collaboration with Fédération Française des Ass. Philatéliques (FFAP) to expand the National Philatelic Championnat with an international section in app. 800 frames.

The International section of Salon Planete Timbres will have two competition classes: Traditionel and Postalhistory. A certain number of the 800 frames will be allocated to Modern Traditional (after 1945) exhibits.

The exhibition welcome exhibitors from all FEPA Member Federations. The FEPA Congress in Opatija in April granted FEPA Support to the exhibiton.

The annual Salon Planete Timbres has become a tradition that attracts a countless number of visitors representing all ages – a tradition with a promotional effect on philately of dimensions beyond description.



In 2010 there was a special focus on agricultural products.

The stampexhibition is part of a huge Stampfair with normally more than 100 dealers, postal administrations and stands with focus on tourist industry, regional products etc.

The main idea is to present stamps to the visitors in a major context that combine the interest for stamps with other interests.

Major areas are normally reserved for the youth with the purpose to introduce stamps as a source to gain knowledge within areas as history, geography animals, plants etc.

The overall set-up has been recognizable from one year to another, but each year always present new initiatives – always with focus on how to optimize the promotion of our common hobby and to make sure that the hobby of stampcollecting will be carried forward to the next generation.
