Dear President,

It is my duty and pleasure to call for the nomination of candidates for the **2018 FEPA Medals and Certificates of Appreciation**. This official request is sent out via e-mail to all member Federations

- **Deadline: 28 February 2019.**

Hereafter you will find some remarks and recommendations based on the experience of the last years. Furthermore, the Guidelines containing the definitions and requirements for nominations are attached to this letter.

- **Communications: via e-mail only;** I shall confirm receipt immediately.
- **Nominations: Short and effective information,** long documents must necessarily be shortened. Since the proposer is supposed to have the best knowledge of the subject, he/she is the most appropriate person to select the important concepts to be kept.
- **Literature entries description:** just a **short abstract**, in **few lines**. not a "summary" taking several pages. In such cases it is suggested to add to the abstract a separate document, that could be used for the article in FEPA News.
- **Images resolution:** Logo of the society, Cover of the book, and photo of its author(s). at least **300 dpi** (JPEG file) as they are needed for the press. No .doc or .pdf files.
- **Language: English only.**
- **ALL the requested attachments must accompany the proposal.** Incomplete proposals will be ignored.
- **Letter of consent:** signed by the proposed person(s) (for medals) or by the president of the proposed society (for certificates), not by a federation's officer.
- **Books: to be sent directly to José Ramón Moreno.** Shipment tracking data are welcome.

All publications submitted for the FEPA Medal for Research will be presented in FEPA News, advertising them to the whole European philatelic community.
