SOFIZ I, first-ever Serbian Online Philatelic Exhibition with International participation will be held from 7th to 14th December 2020. which will be displayed on www.philaserbia.com

2.

The exhibition is being organized by Union of Philatelists of Serbia. The exhibition is technically realized by the Organizing committee, which is appointed by the SFS Board of Directors.

3.

This is a national exhibition with international participation. There is no participation fee in Honorary / Competitive class.

4.

All SFS members have the right to participate in the exhibition as well as members of other national philatelic organizations from abroad.

5.

The Commissioner of the exhibition, on behalf of the Organizing Committee, collects applications for participation in the exhibition. It assigns accepted applications to the following exhibition classes:

B.1. Traditional philately

Exhibit Entry Format:

Sheet Size:

- 1) 210 X 297 mm (A4) and/or
- 2) 420 x 297 mm (A3)

All exhibit scans must be in JPEG format only. No other format will be accepted.

A 300 dpi scan is a must. Please do not send 600 dpi or 1200 dpi scans.

In the case of a sheet size of 210 X 297 mm (A4), file size per page should not be more than 1 MB.

In case of sheet size 420 x 297 mm (A3), file size per page should not be more than 2 MB.

File name corresponds to the numbering of the exhibit list, as follows:

80-page exhibit 210 X 297 mm (A4): numbering 1-80

128-page exhibit 210 X 297 mm (A4): numbering 1-128

40-page exhibit 420 x 297 mm (A3): numbering 1-40

64-page exhibit 420 x 297 mm (A3): numbering 1-64

One-frame exhibit 210 X 297 mm (A4): numbering 1-16

One-frame exhibit 420 x 297 mm (A3): numbering 1-8

7.

The exhibitor is obliged to submit the exhibition in the required jpg format and in the required 300 dpi quality.

No editing/alteration/modification of scanned item/s in whatsoever manner will be allowed or accepted.

The jury reserves the right to review the submitted exhibition and decide on any rejection, if the exhibition does not comply with the rules.

In case of any dispute, the decision of juries and organisers will be final. It cannot be challenged.

8.

Every participant can fill up unlimited applications forms.

Exhibits from abroad will be accepted if they treat themes related to the West Balkan philately (former Yugoslavia), except for classes 5, 6 and 12.

Exhibits must be in Serbian or in one of the languages of the former Yugoslav republic or one of the official FIP languages.

9.

The online format of the exhibition is available via the Internet and in that sense the organizer is not responsible for copying, duplicating or further use of the scanned pages of the exhibition or any part of it.

10.

By submitting the application form to the Commissioner, exhibitors accept all the provisions of this IREX. An exhibitor who does not send the registered exhibit, or rejects the jury's marks, will not be able to participate in the exhibitions during the next 3 years.

11.

Jury decisions and evaluations are final and will be public.

Diploma valid for large silver medal 70 to 74 points

All prizes including The SOFIZ Grand Prix are awarded to participants in the form of an electronic certificate.

Registration of exhibits by 15th October, 2020.

Sending scanned exhibit by 30th November, 2020.

Exhibition 7th December, 2020 - 14th December, 2020.

The results will be published on the website of the exhibition on December 14th, 2020, and the Organizing Committee of the exhibition will inform each candidate by e-mail.

The Union of Philatelists of Serbia will save all participated exhibits in the archives of its website, if the competitor agrees with that.
