Subject: FEPA Awards Program 2024 – Call for Nominations

The Board is pleased to invite nominations for the 2024 FEPA Awards program based on the attached **Guidelines**.

The FEPA Awards Program 2024 includes the following awards:

1. FEPA medal for exceptional service or support to organised philately - 2023
2. FEPA medal for exceptional philatelic research – 2023
3. FEPA certificate of appreciation for outstanding philatelic societies

FEPA medal for exceptional service or support to organised philately

Nominations may be presented only by member federations.

Nominees must be individuals, not groups of two or more people.

Only one medal may be awarded. In exceptional cases, an additional medal may be awarded “in memoriam” in case of the person's death since 1st January of the year concerned.

FEPA medal for exceptional philatelic research

Nominations may be presented by member federations by email.

The research must be published at the earliest after 31 December 2022.

Nominated entries must be presented both in pdf file and in one copy, sent to respectively

The FEBA Board shall appoint a panel of experts to assess the entries and suggest the best of them.

If the best research has been performed by two or more people, a maximum of two medals may be awarded at the discretion of the FEPA Board. All other people concerned shall receive a certificate of appreciation.

Only one medal may be awarded. In exceptional cases, a second medal may be awarded as well. Runners-up shall receive a certificate.

Please note that



- a) the publication period has been set to last year only, as the new provisions make it possible to present one year's publications in the following year. Hence, runners-up of the previous year are no longer considered as candidates.
- b) publications **MUST** be presented as a PDF file to allow sharing them with the panel and within the Board. This helps to avoid problems with the delivery process, as experienced in the last years in receiving the paper copies. However, paper copies are welcome as additional support for the Board's final decision. The shipping address will be circulated after the Board meeting venue is decided.

FEPA Certificate of Appreciation for Outstanding Philatelic Societies

Nominations may be presented only by member federations.

Please note there is no deadline, as the Board will consider applications all year long.
