Germany Philatelic Society Adds to their Boston 2026 Support

Boston 2026 officers have acknowledged an additional \$2,000 donation received from the Germany Philatelic Society of the USA to further fund the international exhibition.

From their By-laws, "The object and purpose of the Society is the documentation, preservation, advancement and promotion of the stamps and postal history of Germany and its related areas through education, study, research and services."

Member benefits include issues of the GPS Specialist journal, access to an extensive literature library, regularly scheduled auctions, identification assistance and participation in various study units. The GPS has local chapters in several states.

The Germany Philatelic Society is teaming up with the Bund Deutscher Philatelisten e.v. (Federation of German Philatelists) based in Bonn to host a separate exhibition within Boston 2026. This will be their fourteenth joint German American Salon, taking place every three years and alternating between the two countries, highlighting material related to all areas of German philately and its possessions. There is a members-only non-competitive display of exhibits with 25 frames allocated to each organization. Expect to see some interesting material in the frames. Members of the German Colonies Collectors Group will also be in attendance.

GPS President Ken Gilbert said, "I am very excited about the opportunity to exhibit and enjoy camaraderie among German collectors during the Boston 2026 show. We are happy to assist the organizing committee in this effort with our donations. I have fond memories of my first international show, Interphil 76, in my home town of Philadelphia almost 50 years ago. So, I can't wait for Boston!"
