Regulations

These regulations are based on the GREX and the individual regulations for Beirut 2026 IREX (Individual Regulations for the Exhibition).

Condition of Participation

Participation in the three Competitive Classes specified below is open to all exhibitors who are members of the Associations that have received invitation from the Organizing Committee.

Classification of Exhibits

The Exhibition will cover by **One Frame only**, classes of **Traditional Philately, Postal History** and **Thematic**.

Application

Application from the Federations is to be made on the official entry form along with the title page of the exhibit to the organizing committee until **15 October 2026**.

The display frame will have a capacity for 16 (4x4) standard size sheets of 23 x 29 cm. Sheets larger than 23 cm x 29 cm as well as **black** or **dark colored** sheets **will not be accepted**.

Entry Fee

The participation fee will be **50 US\$** per each collection. Payment accepted under request by Paypal.

Handling of Exhibits

- It is mandatory to submit images of the collection in PDF format by **20 October 2026**.
- Exhibits delivered by Commissioners must reach the Organizing Committee by 20 November 2026.
- Each exhibit sheet must be placed in a transparent protective cover.
- The sheets shall be numbered on each page.
- Exhibits will be returned after the closing of the show on 22 November 2026.

Judgment and Awards

Members of the Juries will be appointed by the Organizing Committee. The decisions of the Juries are final and cannot be contested. Judging will be carried out in accordance with the FIP General Regulation for the Evaluation of Competitive Exhibits, and the FIP Special Regulation for each class.

For each Class, the awards are medals and participation certificate.

Security Measures

The Organizing Committee will take hard reasonable precautions to ensure that adequate security is provided to protect the exhibits during the Exhibition period. However, the Organizers shall not bear any liability for loss or damage that might occur during the transportation, mounting, or dismounting during the exhibition and return of the exhibits.

Every exhibitor shall insure the exhibits at his or her own expense.

Rights of the Organizing Committee

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make changes in the IREX (Individual Regulations for the Exhibition).

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to decide on any questions not covered by the FEPA and FIP Regulations or by the IREX, and its decisions shall be final.

Acceptance of IREX for Beirut 2026

By signing the Exhibit Application Form, the exhibitor is bound by these special regulations for the Beirut 2026 Stamp Exhibition.
